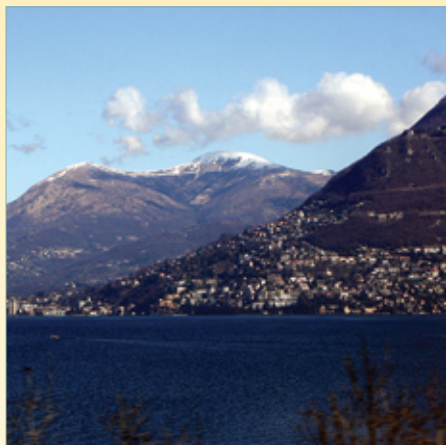

JUN 29, 2022: OVERNIGHT FLIGHT Departure from the United States.

JUN 30, 2022: MONTECATINI Welcome to Italy! Arrive in Florence, meet your tour manager and transfer to your hotel in Tuscany. Check in, freshen up and this evening, enjoy a welcome dinner and tour orientation with your Tour Manager. (D)

JUL 1, 2022: MONTECATINI This morning after breakfast, enjoy a full-day excursion through the Tuscan countryside. You will start by visiting the medieval hill town of Montepulciano, famous as the source of the region's wine industry. After spending time exploring this lovely, historic town, journey to Pienza, another small Tuscan gem of a town with a wonderful charm. Later today, visit the Benedictine monastery of Monte Oliveto Maggiore to hear the Gregorian chants by the monks at Vespers! Dinner will be 'Tuscan-style' in a nearby restaurant before returning to your hotel. (B,D)

JUL 2, 2022: MONTECATINI Today will be spent visiting Florence, the city that gave birth to the Renaissance! Explore this vibrant city with a local tour guide and enjoy entrance to the Accademia to view Michelangelo's 'Il Davide.' This afternoon, enjoy some free time before preparing for your first concert performance at Chiesa di San Gaetano (pending confirmation). Dinner will be on your own tonight. (B)

JUL 3, 2022: MONTECATINI This morning, you may choose to visit the world-famous Carrara marble quarries (additional cost applicable). Alternatively, you may choose to spend the morning in the lovely town of Sarzana. Enjoy lunch on your own at Marina di Carrara before transferring to the medieval city

of Lucca where you will give your next concert performance at Chiesa Santa Maria Nera (pending approval). Enjoy dinner on your own this evening. (B)

JUL 4, 2022: LAKE GARDA This morning after breakfast, head north to Lake Garda. En route, we will stop in Modena, home to two bastions of Italian life - Balsamic Vinegar and Ferrari! Today, you will taste the famed vinegar and opt to stop at the Ferrari museum to test drive the most iconic fast car in history (additional cost for car driving)! Later, continue to Lake Garda, the largest lake in Italy with its clear waters and mountain back drop. It is surrounded by towns and beautiful scenery. On arrival, check into your hotel and have dinner on your own tonight. (B)

JUL 5, 2022: LAKE GARDA This morning after breakfast, explore the lake area with your tour manager, an area of outstanding natural beauty. Late this afternoon, transfer and rehearse for tonight's concert performance at Chiesa Santa Maria Assunta in the heart of Riva del Garda (pending approval). Dinner is on your own. (B)

JUL 6, 2022: LAKE GARDA Today, the group will have the opportunity to spend the entire day exploring and walking in the Dolomite Mountain region! Dinner will be on your own. (B)

JUL 7, 2022: VENICE This morning after breakfast, depart for Venice stopping en route in the lovely city of Verona, home of Juliet's Balcony and a wonderful Roman area still used to this day for summer operas. Continue to a Prosecco winery where you may opt for a tasting! Continue to Venice, check in to your last hotel before relaxing in the local area or heading onto Venice Island for dinner on your own. (B)

JUL 8, 2022: VENICE This morning after breakfast, explore Venice with your tour manager; see St. Mark's Square, the magnificent Basilica, and the famous "Bridge of Sighs" which connects the Doge's Palace to the old prison. The afternoon is yours to explore further at your own pace. During your free time, you may wish to take a gondola ride through the city's beautiful canals or visit the Peggy Guggenheim museum, or enjoy a glass-blowing demonstration! Dinner is on your own. (B)

JUL 9, 2022: VENICE This morning after breakfast, have free time to explore Venice on your own. Later this afternoon, transfer to your final concert venue to prepare for this evening's final concert at Chiesa di San Rocco! Celebrate your successful performance tour with final dinner together this evening! (B,D)
